The College of Engineering Curriculum Committee met on December 1, 2016 at 3:30 pm in Driftmier Room 316b

The Committee reviewed the revision to earlier submitted change proposals:

- After the November 23 curriculum committee meeting, the suggested modifications to ENGR 2120 were discussed with the instruction faculty teaching that course. The modification is to make ENGR 1140 a full prerequisite for ENGR 2120, rather than just a pre- or co-requisite, and the curriculum committee has approved this course change as modified.

The Committee approved the following proposals:

- The set of course prefix changes provided by the academic office were reviewed. A few modifications were noted, as summarized here:
 - ENGG 4620 will be designated as CSEE 4620 (Biomedical Imaging)
 - MCHE 3140 (Engineering Thermodynamics) will be changed in designation to ENGR 3140. (The existing ENGR 3140 on the books is a 2-credit hour course, which was the former version that existed prior to ~2014).
 - ENGR 4760/6760 (Biomechanics) will be changed to MCHE 4760/6760
 - ENGR 8240 (Instrumentation Programming) will be changed to ELEE 8240
 - The new course ENGR 4790 will be changed to ELEE 4790

The Committee returned the following course proposals:

- None.

Other business:

- The committee briefly discussed the proposed Graduate Certificate in Sustainability but deferred action on this until the next meeting in January.

The meeting adjourned at 4:00 pm.
