



Visiting Research Scholar Opening at the University of Georgia, USA

The Nanoelectrochemistry lab at the University of Georgia, has an immediate opening for an electrochemist visiting scholar. The candidate will be working primarily in energy storage materials, but will also assist in other ongoing projects in the laboratory. Previous experience in electrochemical research is required. The lab is equipped with multichannel potentiostats, impedance analyzers, scanning electrochemical microscope (SECM), battery and fuel cell test stations, coin cell fabrication equipment, quartz crystal microbalance and spectrophotometers. Candidate will also have the opportunity to use the wide range of nanofabrication facilities available at the NanoSEC (www.nano.uga.edu) for his/her research. The position is for one year with the possibility of extension based on the availability of funds.
